


Proposal for JCBF decision

For minutes of JCBF meeting



- 1. Within next JCBF written procedures JCBF members to assess critically all 4 new strategic initiatives (0.35 MEUR) in the light of remaining funding (0.49 MEUR)
- 2. Leave a reserve for Programme bilateral initiatives ~ 0.5 MEUR
- 3. Temporarily suspend new strategic initiatives from 2020. NFP & donors to inform stakeholders + information on web pages
