






## Status update on the Fund for Regional Cooperation and the Fund for Youth Employment

### Fund for Regional Cooperation

- 713 applications were submitted before the deadline
- 597 applications have been assessed by the FMO
- The high number of applications has resulted in delays
- The Financial Mechanism Committee will in February make a decision on which projects will be selected for the second application round







### Fund for Youth Employment


- 27 projects were selected by the Financial Mechanism Committee to received funding from the EEA and Norway Grants Fund for Youth Employment






# Labour market Employment for young Adults with a Disability – LEAD




Young adults with disabilities are a vulnerable group in many countries in Europe. Often, schools do not accommodate their needs, and many end up unemployed and in poverty, or dependent on their family members. It is necessary to address the specific needs of young adults with a disability and make sure they are not discriminated against in education or employment.



## Youth Employment Network for Energy Sustainability in Islands



One of the lasting challenges of the financial crisis in Europe is the fact that many young people with a completed education cannot find jobs. This is especially true if they live in remote areas like islands, where seasonal unemployment is prevalent. There is a need to create jobs where people live, from resources found in those areas, that can create a sustainable future. European islands have many challenges and opportunities in common, like stress on resources during the summer months, youth migration to the mainland, but, also, potential to become test-beds for new technologies.
