Strategic Reports

- Only 2017 + 2018 reports remaining
- Several teams in FMO use the Strategic Report
- Should provide a 'snapshot of progress'
 - Describe relevant contextual trends
 - Provide main results <u>and analysis</u>
 - Analyse the good/more difficult programmes
 - Include planned and implemented evaluations
- Focus on the Executive Summary
- FMO will provide an (annotated) template for 2017 report

Strategic Reports


2018 report submission dates:

- 4 BS with Combined Reports = by end January
- For countries with early Annual Meetings,
 a 'light version' of annual strategic report = by end March
- Final strategic report for all BS = by end June
- Remember to publish your Strategic Reports!

FMO will provide an annotated template for the 'light', the combined and the final Strategic Reports.

NFP Evaluations



- All BS are required to carry out evaluations of programmes (Article 9.1 of the Regulation)
- NFP evaluations:
 - 2 BS have completed evaluations
 - 1 has ongoing evaluation
 - 6 BS have planned evaluations
 - ... For 7 BS we have no information
 - If in doubt, opt for ex-post evaluations assessing "results and wider effects"
 - Remaining TA budget can be used/PO management costs
